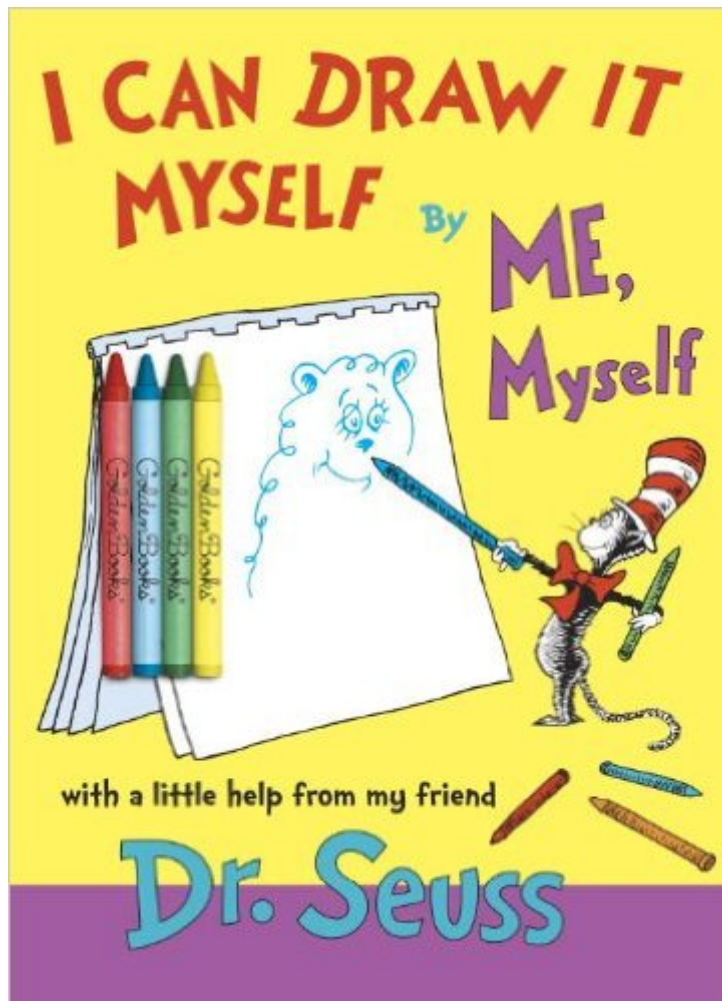

We're HUGE Dr. Seuss fans in our home, where I babysit our two grandsons, ages 5 and 14 months. Given the four year age difference between them, their interests and abilities are quite different. When #2 came along, with all of the instantaneous needs and demands involved with a newborn, I wanted to make sure to be able to carve out several special "one-on-one" times throughout the day with my older grandchild. One of those was lunchtime, when Baby Brother was napping and we could curl up with his choice of several Seuss books I'd read to him while he was eating his lunch. Little Brother is now awake at lunchtime, and while he's content to sit in his little
