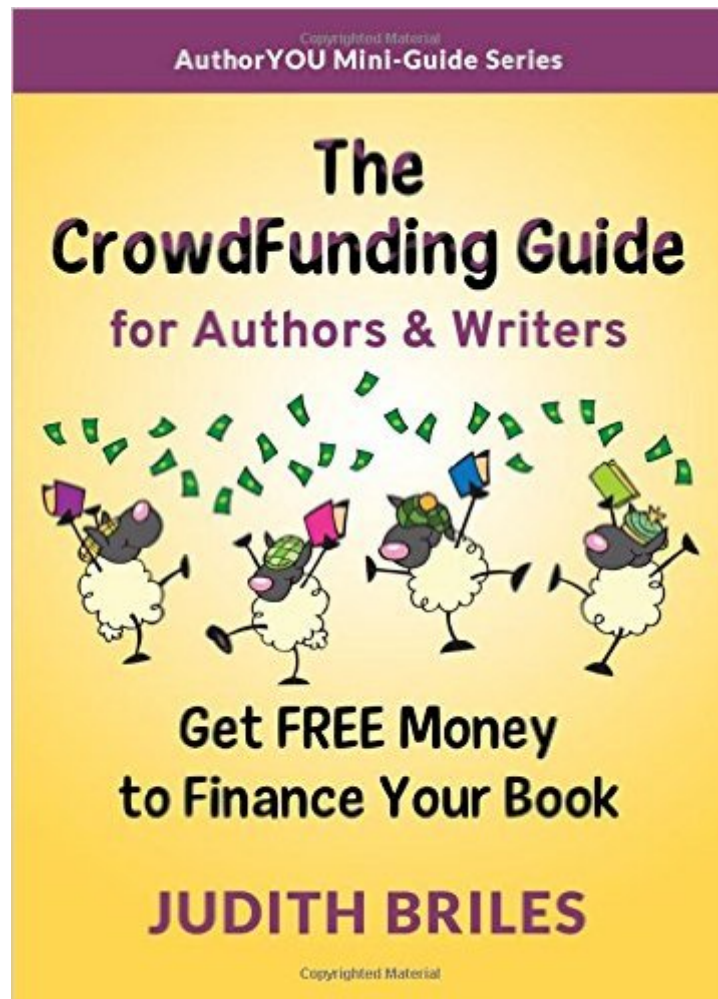

percent of publishing campaigns succeed." 70% fail, but you don't have to be one of those. With a good idea, HARD WORK, and this book, you CAN succeed. I purchased this book at an Author U event, and it was well worth it to have a goldmine of information at my fingertips.
